



## Youth & Certified IN Bred Program Manager

The Indiana Pork Youth & Certified IN Bred Program Manager is a full-time position that will assist in daily management of checkoff activities including Indiana Pork Youth programs and administer the Certified IN Bred program.

### Checkoff Activities

- Participate in Youth Committee and assist with planning Indiana Pork Youth sponsored activities including Young Professionals Conference and State Fair Skillathon
- Teach youth and the public about pork production through Operation Main Street and other educational activities
- Maintain the Indiana Pork website coordinating content with all staff
- Assist with Indiana Pork communications to producers, allied industry, and other stakeholders
- Assist with Indiana State Fair activities and concessions as needed
- Assist with promotion of Indiana Pork events in coordination with all staff
- Assist other staff with event management tasks as appropriate
- Assist in administrative activities for office operations

### Certified Indiana Bred Activities

- Manage annual breeder enrollment and breeder benefits
- Coordinate CIB entries, show management and awards at Indiana State Fair
- Manage CIB Advisory Board meetings and reports to Indiana Pork Board
- Coordinate CIB sponsorship with assistance of CIB Advisory Board
- Manage promotion of CIB to Indiana swine exhibitors and updates to the CIB website
- Participate in swine exhibition events for CIB promotion as appropriate
- Assist with CIB finances and governance under guidance of Director of Producer Education

Applicants with a bachelor's level degree in an agriculture related field and experience in the swine exhibition industry are preferred. Applicants should have good communication skills and be able to work in a team environment. Familiarity with web design and development of social media campaigns is preferred. The position will be located at the Indiana Pork offices in Indianapolis, Indiana. Some travel will be required.

The position will report to the Executive Director.
